Parent/Carer Code of Conduct

Play your part and support your child/young person to be part of the team:

- Support the coaches in their decisions and understand that they make decisions in the best interests of the team
- Communicate with the coach if your child or young person is not going to be able to attend training or a match
- Let the coach know if you have any concerns about your child or young person – health, emotional, behaviour etc
- Encourage your player to participate in all aspects of the team's activities
- If you have any concerns, please address these with the coach or the club's welfare officer

Play your part and support your team in matches:

- Celebrate effort and good play from both sides
- Always respect the Referee and coaches and encourage players to do the same
- Stay behind the touchline and within the Designated Spectators' Area (where provided)
- When players make mistakes, offer them encouragement
- Never engage in, or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour
- Respect the manager/coaches' decisions, appreciating they are doing what they believe is best for the whole team

I understand that if I do not follow the Code of Conduct, I may be:

- Issued with a verbal warning or asked to leave
- Asked to complete an appropriate FA course
- Required to meet with the club committee, league or County FA Officer
- Be issued a fine
- Requested not to attend future games, training sessions or be suspended
- Required to leave the club along with any dependents
