Player Code of Conduct

When playing football, I must:

- Always do my best in training and matches, even when we are losing
- Play fairly and be friendly
- Respect my team-mates, the other team, the referee and my coaches
- Not use foul or abusive language or spit
- Play by the rules and listen to the referee
- Shake hands with the team – win or lose
- Listen and respect what my coach tells me
- Understand that a coach has to do what is best for the team
- Talk to someone I trust or the club welfare officer if I am unhappy about anything at my club.
- Respect the facilities at home and away

I understand that if I do not follow the Code, any/all of the following actions may be taken by my club, County FA or the FA:

I may:

- Be asked to say sorry to my team-mates, the other team, referee or team manager
- Be dropped, substituted or suspended from training
- Be subject to the Spalding United Youth Football Club's Disciplinary Policy
- Receive a formal warning from my coach or the club committee
- Be required to leave the club

In addition:

- My club, may make my parent or carer aware if I break the Code of Conduct
- The FA/County FA could impose a fine and suspension against my club.
